Call for Papers

The *Jagannath University Journal of Psychology* announces herewith a call for scientific articles for its next volume to be published in **December, 2017**. Submitting paper should be in close connection with the psychology or behavioral fields based on the empirical research, paper review, theory formation or invention.

Manuscript Preparation

The manuscript must be written in following the style outline of the **Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association** shortly instructed below:

The manuscript must be written in English typed in MS Word with double space, 12-pt Times New Roman, on A4, sheets (**not exciding 16 pages all together**) leaving appropriate margin (left and top 3-cm, right and bottom 2-cm) and should be numbered from the Title page.

- 1. One hard copy of each manuscript along with a CD, and/or soft copy through e-mail (word version in attach file) should be sent to the Editor-in-Chief as mentioned below.
- 2. The first page should contain: Title, Name(s) and Affiliation of Author(s), Address of corresponding author including e-mail address and cell number.
- 3. The 2nd page includes: Title, Short-running head, Abstract within 200 words, and Key-words (maximum 5).
- 4. From the 3rd Page (i) Introduction (without heading), (ii) Method, (iii) Results, (iv) Discussion and Conclusion, Acknowledgements (if any), References, Appendix (if any), etc.
- 5. Minimum number of Tables or Figures should be cited not repeating each other.
- Authors are requested to make necessary language correction before submitting a manuscript to JnUJP.
